- What's the data on the children who are being brought to the attention of the people who track attendance and what is the follow up on that?
- What is the protocol for tracking students/how can the school district beyond their main teacher support outreach to check on students who have been MIA?
- How do lateness, or schedule changes (meetings on an asynchronous day), or absences due to doctor's appointments, etc... impact grading? What is the communication protocol for students/parents in these situations?
- What are the special education dropout rates? Or rates of participation?
- What is the ENL dropout rate? And participation rates within classes?
- How are we assessing the mental health for students and staff? Based on these assessments, how can the district budget for the needs anticipated for 2021-22.

- Black History Month education/curriculum/celebrations across NPCSD: Black Lives Matter informational flyer (AHS) and support for curriculum development (Jenn P. 1/20/21 email; Sara Shepphard's email 1/16/21)
 - Allison NPMS PTA Feb meeting agenda includes questions posed to Mrs. Sheldon about how Black History Month and Black Lives Matter are being addressed.
 - Duzine is putting up a bulletin board displaying the principles of the Black Lives Matter movement.
 - Kristen Teachers are sharing resources, but no directives on how to use them.
 - Alana at the high school Black History Month is acknowledged, but instructional content doesn't change
 - Jenn teachers need to learn the content before they can teach it What does this say about the district?
 - *Teachers need training BOE set aside funds.*

- Is it possible for the BOE to adopt a policy regarding how Black History is taught? (not just Black history...) BOE needs to set tone and policy. Building admin needs to follow-through and hold teachers accountable.
- Is there a point-person for equity work in the district? Is it Ricky Butler? We do not have access to any decision-makers (We have never had a principal attend a REIAC)
- Buildings have Equity teams can a member from each committee attend *REAIC?*
- How is the BOE held accountable? REIAC recommends that the BOE participates in Undoing Racism.
- Because Generation Ready didn't work out, what are the next steps? How the district plan to hold itself accountable to the BOE's Anti-racist statement?
- REIAC is requesting a meeting with Superintendent Urbina Medina to discuss REIAC's charge and how we can be more effective and more collaborative with the district.

 - Reflection: anti-racism work needs to involve everyone... top down, and all ways.
 - People on the BOE are the gatekeeper, they need to develop an equity lens.
