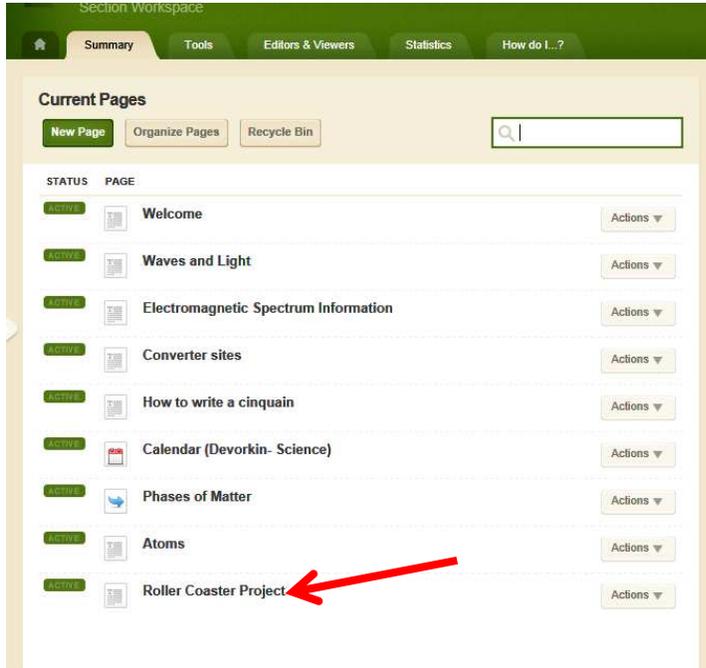
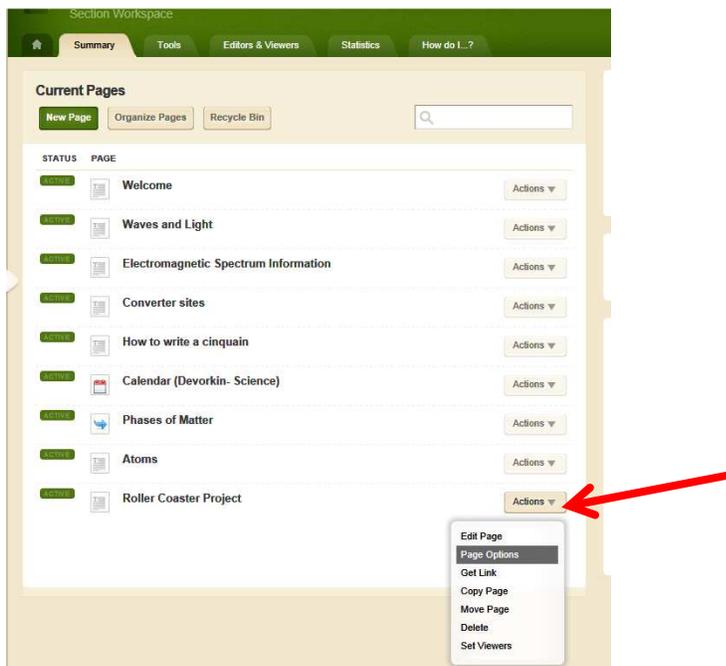


Mapping to a website
