SUBJECT: RANK IN CLASS

All students will be listed in a chronological order from the highest scholastic average to the lowest scholastic average. For purposes of ranking, Advanced Placement and college level courses will be weighted differently than Regents and school level courses. The weighting for GPA purposes will be as follows:

School/Regents Courses	1.00
Advanced Placement/College Level Courses	1.06

The weighted grades will be used to determine GPA's for students beginning in grade 10 and thereafter.

The New Paltz Central School District provides for a dual ranking system for students graduating at the end of their Junior year. Juniors will be ranked next to the identical scholastic Senior average using the designation of "A" (accelerated) next to the student's name. The process will be provided for students to be ranked outside the ranking procedure used for regular four-year graduates.
