SUBJECT: STUDENT USE OF PERSONAL TECHNOLOGY

The District reserves the right to restrict student use of District-owned technologies and personal technology on school property or at school-sponsored events. Students must follow the guidelines for use set out in the District Code of Conduct and the AUP at all times. Consequences for misuse are set forth in the District's Code of Conduct.

_____ The District will not be liable for the loss, damage, misuse, or theft of any personal technology brought to any of its schools. The District reserves the right to monitor, inspect, and/or confiscate personal technology when the administration has reasonable suspicion to believe that a violation of school policy or criminal law has occurred.

The Board expressly prohibits use of personal technology in locker rooms, restrooms, Health Offices, and any other areas where a person would reasonably expect some degree of personal privacy.
