**5. SUPERINTENDENT’S REPORTS & DISCUSSION ITEMS**

Superintendent Rice stated there is a letter in the packets from the New Paltz Police Department regarding support of the work on South Putt Corners Road.

Superintendent Rice also stated she received a letter from a parent who has a disabled student walking to school with a safety issue. Mrs. Rice stated she was in touch with the Chief Snyder and he contacted the Mayor and from there they are trying to set up a crossing guard at that intersection.

Superintendent Rice stated Suzi Popielusko's desk has been moved. The area where her desk was is a dedicated Board area, however there is no computer there anymore. Mrs. Rice stated there is wireless internet available, but if members need to use this area they must bring their own lap tops.

#### 3-8 ASSESSMENTS AND NEW CUT SCORE

Superintendent Rice stated it is challenging explaining to parents why children who were always seen as proficient are now falling below standards. Mrs. Rice stated the assessments were changed from what they originally were after the school year had started. Superintendent Rice also stated there was a change in the expectation of students. Mrs. Rice stated they are using college rubrics. Superintendent Rice stated they want schools to have higher standards, and our tests were not as rigorous as they should have been. This is why they changed the cut scores. Level 1 is below standards. Level 2 meets basic standards, but is not at the proficient level. Level 3 meets proficient standard. Level 4 is above standards. Superintendent Rice noted that the raw score was 650 before.

Superintendent Rice stated all students will be analyzed according to the new standards for academic intervention services. All students on levels 1 and 2 and borderline level 3 will be assessed by the district.

#### FEDERAL JOBS ACT AND IMPACT ON NPCSD

Superintendent Rice stated there has been no action by our legislature or government as of today. Superintendent Rice stated there is conflicting information coming out regarding when and how you can use the funding. Mrs. Rice stated she is unsure what the legislature is going to do, however any incoming money will help for the upcoming school year. Discussion ensued.

#### CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SERVICES FOR EMERGENCY PROJECTS

Superintendent Rice stated The Palumbo Group has been engaged, and they will commence work tomorrow.

### **6. BOARD COMMUNICATIONS**

#### VOTING DELEGATE & ALTERNATE TO NYSSBA

Mr. Rausch stated he is interested in attending. Mr. Greenfield stated he would be the back-up to Mr. Rausch should he not be able to attend.

#### EMERGENCY CAPITAL PROJECT UPDATE – CSArch

Tom Ritzenthaler, Principal Architect at CSArch was at the Board of Education meeting along with Randy Collins, Theresa Grester, and Paige Lewis.

Mr. Ritzenthaler gave a Power Point presentation on the Emergency Projects Update. Mr. Ritzenthaler stated they had four contractors bid on the MS project and five bid on the Lenape Project. Mr. Ritzenthaler stated the MS Project work should be performed before the school year starts. Mr. Ritzenthaler stated none of the work being done at Lenape will interfere with the students or the school day.

Mr. Ritzenthaler stated there is a Type II SEQRA Resolution on the agenda this evening. Mr. Ritzenthaler stated there are no environmental impacts of the resolution presented. Mr. Ritzenthaler stated the contractors are all aware that evening and weekend work will be necessary in order to not interfere with the school day.

Randy Collins next discussed the Emergency Projects Update. Paige Lewis, a licensed architect is going to be the project manager and was also present. Theresa Grester is responsible for communications.

#### COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT PROCESS FOR DISTRICT FACILITIES REVIEW- CSArch

Mr. Ritzenthaler stated this is a district wide project. Mr. Ritzenthaler stated CSArch suggests having open enrollment community meetings, which will be the community's exposure regarding Board actions and the progress of the projects. Mr. Ritzenthaler stated there will be meetings at the beginning of the process, and other meetings throughout the process. Mr. Ritzenthaler stated there will be district building/department meetings to the staff involved at the buildings to give critical day-to-day prospective from those that are being affected. Mr. Ritzenthaler stated there will also be stakeholder group meetings, which will help in the master collection point and analysis.

Mr. Ritzenthaler noted the stakeholder groups have an open enrollment process. He discussed those people from various groups in the community that have an impact on the community that may take part in the stakeholder group. Mr. Ritzenthaler stated the objective is not to exclude anyone. The groups are facilitated by CSArch, and they document attendance and take minutes of each meeting. Each group will select a Chairperson by straw poll, and an individual can only Chair one group. Mr. Ritzenthaler stated the members must be residents or pay school taxes. Mr. Ritzenthaler stated the stakeholder groups will be given a “charge of duties and responsibilities” by the Board of Education including a schedule and instruction on how findings will be presented.

Mr. Ritzenthaler stated the Input Committees serve as a resource to the Advisory Committee. Mr. Ritzenthaler stated they are not committee members. Mr. Ritzenthaler stated the Input Committee Data, the Analyzed District Data, and the analyzed Stakeholder Data will all be funneled to the Long Range Plan Advisory Committee. Mr. Ritzenthaler stated the Long Range Plan Advisory Committee will have a Chairperson from each Stakeholder Group with no BOE or administration representation. Members again must be either a District resident or pay district school taxes.

Mr. Ritzenthaler stated building condition surveys have begun, and education program reviews. Mr. Ritzenthaler stated this is a part of any long-range plan.

Theresa Grester spoke about communication and how important it is during long range planning processes.

Paige Lewis spoke of a schedule of possible meeting dates and times to commence and carryout the open community process where interested people of the community can come and get involved and informed. Discussion ensued.

Superintendent Rice stated the Allegory Studios letter provided to Board members in the packet needs to be considered at the September 1, 2010 BOE Meeting. The superintendent stated that this information was not included in the original proposal. Ms. Tobin Flusser requested monetary amounts be included in the information provided. Superintendent Rice stated she will have this information for the next meeting.

A Motion was made by Mr. Torres and seconded by Mr. Rich that the Board of Education approve the following resolution:

**6.1 Request For Approval of SEQRA – Type II Negative Declaration Emergency Projects**

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education of the New Paltz Central School District, upon the recommendation of Maria C. Rice, Superintendent of Schools, does hereby approve the following SEQRA – Type II Negative Declaration Emergency Projects Resolution:

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education of the New Paltz Central School District has two emergency projects, one involving the removal of existing gutters at New Paltz Middle School, putting up temporary gutters and associated actions and one involving the removal and replacement of portions of a masonry wall at the Lenape School gymnasium, with structural bracing and associated actions, (the “Proposed Action”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education wishes to comply with the requirements of the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA); and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education has reviewed the proposed Scope of Work and views the collective Scope of Work as one Proposed Action; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education has consulted with its Architects with respect to the potential for environmental impacts resulting from the Proposed Action; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education has reviewed the Proposed Action with respect to the Type II criteria set forth in the SEQRA Regulations at 6 NYCRR Part 617.5 and has determined that the Proposed Action is a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(1), (2) and (8) of the SEQRA Regulations;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Education of the New Paltz Central School District is hereby designated lead agency under SEQRA for the Proposed Action; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Board of Education hereby determines that the emergency repairs in the nature of the removal of existing gutters at New Paltz Middle School, putting up temporary gutters and associated actions and the removal and replacement of portions of a masonry wall at the Lenape School gymnasium, with structural bracing and

associated actions, as one collective Proposed Action, is a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(1), (2) and (8) of the SEQRA Regulations and will not have a significant adverse impact on the environment, and that no further review of the Proposed Action is required.

The contact person for the New Paltz Central School District is: Mr. Richard Linden, Assistant Superintendent of Schools.

#### **6.4 Request for Approval to Support the Repaving of South Putt Corners Road**

A Motion was made by Mr. Greenfield and seconded by Ms. Tobin Flusser that the Board of Education approve the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education of the New Paltz Central School District supports the efforts of the New Paltz Bicycle-Pedestrian Committee to improve the safety on South Putt Corners Road for students, staff and community members by repaving this critical artery to the New Paltz Central High School thus providing safer passage of this thoroughfare for both motorized and non-motorized users; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Education encourages Ulster County Department of Public Works to set the improvements of South Putt Corners Road as a priority, ensuring that the work commences as soon as possible by returning the highway project to its former high-priority status, and not postpone the project until 2014 in order to improve the safety on South Putt Corners Road for students, staff and community members.
