The statement is in the minutes section titled 'Board Communications – Correction'. The statement is evidence that the board does not understand racism when they disavow my response to a racial attack. I was the victim of a racial attack and when I identified it as a racist act the board made me the victimizer. This demonstrates the lack of understanding of racism and institutional racism. I will further elaborate on this matter in a letter to the New Paltz Times."
