WHEREAS, in order for Ulster County ("County") to reconstruct the highway on South Putt Corners Road (CR 17), New Paltz, New York, pursuant to the South Putt Corners Road (CR 17) Rehabilitation Project (the "Project"), the County has requested that the Board of Education of the New Paltz Central School District approve a Temporary Easement Agreement and a Permanent Easement Agreement regarding certain property owned by the New Paltz Central School District ("School District") as described on the DPW right-of-way acquisition map numbered: Map No. 2 & 2A, Parcel No. 2 & 3, for the sum \$13,800.00 (\$300.00 for the Temporary Easement and \$13,500.00 for the Permanent Easement; and

WHEREAS, the County seeks the conveyance of the Temporary and Permanent Easements on the School District's real property for the purpose of maintaining, repairing, and reconstructing the highway, including excavations thereupon, over or across the land, as described in the Temporary Easement Agreement and Deed of Temporary Easement, and the Agreement to Sell Permanent Easement, all of which are annexed hereto and made a part hereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education, pursuant to authority expressed in §405 of the Education Law, hereby determines that the granting of the Temporary Easement and Permanent Easement, as described are, are in the best interests of the School District and authorizes the Board President to execute (1) the Temporary Easement Agreement, (2) Deed of Temporary Easement, and (3) Agreement to Sell Permanent Easement, as presented to the Board at this meeting, for good and valuable consideration as described above; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board President is further authorized to execute such other documents as are necessary in order to effectuate the transactions with Ulster County.
