March Suggested Activities

Math Sheets: Place value up to the hundreds place.

Reading/Spelling Practice: VCCV words (napkin rule and

rabbit rule) These are two-syllable words with consonants in the medial position. Students can practice decode by splitting the word into two syllables at the two consonants. Students can read through a column each night. They can take their time and decode or they can race against the clock each night to see how fast they can read them. Students should do what makes them comfortable as a reader.

Students can practice spelling these words as well. Using kinesthetic materials like playdough, rice trays, dry erase boards, sky writing, paper and pencil, etc. Adults can give them a word and students can write and spell it using fun materials.
