Algebra 1 is a year-long course that focuses on algebraic expressions, linear, quadratic and exponential equations, functions, and descriptive statistics in real life applications using problem solving and critical thinking skills. This is the first course of the New York State High School Common Core Curriculum for Mathematics, which is directly aligned with the NYS Common Core Algebra 1 Learning Standards. Students will take the NYS CC Algebra 1 Regent Exam at the end of the year.

Grading policies:

- 1. <u>A charged Chromebook:</u> Students are expected to have their charged chrome book EVERY MATH CLASS.
