Literary Genres

Genre	Definition	Example
Fiction	a story that is made up by the author	
Historical Fiction	a story that takes place during an actual time period in history; many of the characters are fictional and many of the events actually happened	
Realistic Fiction	a story that could actually happen, but it did not, it is made up by the author, it takes place in modern times	
Science Fiction	a story that uses science (often technology) to create extraordinary plots	
Fantasy	a story that is imaginary and could include characters such as talking animals or characters with magical powers	
Folklore /includes fairy .les, tall tales,	these stories were passed down from generation to generation verbally; often to explain	
legends, myths, fables)	something in nature or to teach a moral lesson	
Nonfiction	a true story	
Informational	books that give factual information on a variety of topics	
Autobiography	the story of a person's life written by that person	
Biography	the story of a person's life written by someone else

Mystery	a story based on a puzzling crime where the main character tries to solve the crime using clues	
Adventure	a story that has fast moving action	
Poetry	is written in verse and often evokes thought and feeling from the reader
