



### I. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY




### Prime Contract Progress - PROJECTS B, F2, A, D & C:

Project B – Operable Doors: The **General Contractor**, *Key Contracting*, *after multiple discussions has bypassed their subcontractor and are now dealing directly with HUFCOR*, *the manufacturer of the doors*. Safety protocols are the main reason the doors have not been accepted by the project team. Modifications to the doors are being scheduled directly with HUFCOR. This process will not affect the original Hufcor 2 year warranty. The rework now needs to be completed around the districts schedule as there are many activities scheduled in this gym.



**Project F2 – Septic Replacement: The Site Contractor**, *Sunup Enterprises, is substantially complete with the installation of the septic system.* A punch list walkthrough occurred this week. Punch list to be distributed and final turf restoration to be completed by the end of May.

Project A – Duzine Roof: The Roofing Contractor, General Roofing Contractors, have submitted on almost all major items required for them to start work. The project team has agreed, with input from the superintendent and staff, to allow this contractor to start work earlier than shown on the milestone schedule. Roofing materials are on site and work has started. Work is scheduled to be completed by mid to end of July.





Project D – Middle School Roof: The Roofing Contractor, Milcon Construction, have submitted on a majority of the items required to start work, in particular the roofing tile. There has been however an ongoing review of the bonding company's ratings and ability to bond work in NYS. We have currently stopped the contractor from starting any work until this issue is resolved and bonding submission approved by the district's attorney.

The following plans represent logistics discussions that have occurred and that are ongoing when staging for construction on site. These plans have been and continue to be reviewed regularly by the project team. Safety being the number one consideration for approval.









