COVID-19 Screening Attestation

The safety of the employees, students, families, clients, partners and visitors remains our top priority. As the COVID-19 outbreak continues, we will closely monitor the situation and will periodically update our guidance based on current recommendations from New York State.

Based on currently available information and clinical expertise, older adults and people of any age who have serious underlying medical conditions (e.g. serious heart disease, chronic lung disease or asthma, immunocompromised, severe liver disease, etc.) might be at higher risk for severe illness from COVID-19. If you are concerned about underlying medical conditions, please consult with your personal medical health care provider.

To prevent the spread of COVID-19 and reduce the potential risk of exposure to our workforce, we are conducting a simple screening. Your participation is important to help us take precautionary measures to protect you and everyone in this facility. We request you complete this screening everyday prior to entering a facility. Based on your response, you will be informed if you should report to work or if you can enter our facilities.

Screening Questions

Location: Role:

- Since your last day of work, or last visit here, have you had any of these symptoms?
 - Fever (temperature of greater than 100.0° F in the last 14 days)
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Chills
 - Repeated shaking with chills
 - Muscle pain
 - Headache
 - Sore throat
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Gastrointestinal (GI) Symptoms (primarily affecting children only)

Note: Answer "yes" if the symptoms you have experienced in the last 14 days are of greater intensity or frequency than what you normally experience.
- Have you had a positive COVID-19 test within the last 14 days?
- Have you had close contact with a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19 case within 14 days?
- In the past 14 days, have you or your child traveled internationally to a CDC level 2 or 3 COVID-19 related travel health notice country, OR have you traveled to any state other than Vermont, Massachusetts, Connecticut, Pennsylvania or New Jersey?

ATTENDANCE

ASYNCHRONOUS DAYS

Attendance is required on asynchronous days. Make sure your child knows how to access the correct Google Classroom with attendance information.

Tuesdays are check-in days. Students are required to attend their Tuesday classes except for Career and Technical Students at BOCES.

DEVICES

Only school issued devices to 9th Graders will be permitted in school. 9th Graders are expected to bring their devices for in-person learning. Make sure your device is fully charged before arriving to school.

LOCKERS

Lockers will not be available for students. Items cannot be shared by students.

DRESS IN LAYERS

Classroom Windows will be open for ventilation which will cause the heat to increase in the room. The temperature will vary greatly depending on where you are seated. Students will have assigned seats to facilitate tracing protocols.

HELPFUL HINTS

TUESDAYS

Tuesdays have been set aside as 30-minute "live" check-ins with teachers to facilitate remediation, enrichment, one-to-one and/or small group sessions.

Students are expected to access their classes for attendance taking.

REMOTE STUDENTS

Students will be expected to login and verify their attendance. Please recognize longer than usual wait times in the waiting room may occur as teachers are moving around the building
