Dear Families:

On behalf of the staff at New Paltz High School, I want to welcome everyone to the 2020-2021 school year. As we begin the school year with remote learning, I truly believe that we can accomplish most anything if we stick together. We are committed to keeping all stakeholders healthy and safe while we move through this first of a kind experience.

As we move through this process, I will continue to provide updates through School Messenger as information becomes available. I will identify these emails with "NPHS" in the subject line.

We are excited to welcome four new staff members to our school. Valerie Hughes and Fionna McKenna have joined our English Department. Matthew Esposito will be working with Biology and Forensic Science students in our Science Department. John McNally will be working with Global 9 students.

First Day of School

We will begin our school year in a remote setting starting on Tuesday, September 8th. Students will be notified by their teachers via Google Classroom of upcoming asynchronous and synchronous events. For attendance purposes, students should log into their Google Classrooms and fill out a brief Google Form indicating their attendance. **We ask that students check-in on asynchronous days (Tuesday, Thursdays, Fridays) by 2 PM.** If a live meeting is scheduled for Friday, teachers will take attendance during the session. Students attending BOCES will also begin their remote learning on Tuesday, September 8th.

Google Classroom

All students at NPHS will be using Google Classroom as their main remote learning platform. If your student has not received login information or is not able to login in, please complete click on the Remote Learning Technology Support link located in the center of the NPCSD home page.

Fully Remote Learning Schedule

Students are required to attend all scheduled classes with the exception of lunch and study halls. A schedule is provided on the high school website along with the information sent on September 4th.



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Accessing Classes Online

Google Classroom will be the primary communication tool used for assignments, announcements, and class information. After class rosters have been finalized, teachers will begin adding students to their Google Classrooms. Students will receive notifications through their school email account. **Students and their families should be checking their school email accounts, Google Classroom and the school website.**

BOCES Career and Technical Education (CTE) Students

BOCES programming will begin the school year fully remote. Students will be receiving additional information about accessing BOCES programming. On Tuesday, September 22nd, all first year BOCES CTE students will attend BOCES in person for orientation. All other students will remain on remote instruction. On Tuesday, September 29th, all BOCES students will begin attending the Career and Technical Center in person every Tuesday. Transportation will be made available to students.

Free and Reduced Lunch Application

To apply for meal benefits an application must be completed for the 2020-21 school year; only one application is needed per household. Grading

Assessment is a vital piece of information as students progress through their learning. The district is working on a grading policy. Please contact your student's teacher directly if you wish to receive notifications of assignments and/or your student's progress.

Student Workload

Classroom assignments will be given in accordance with NYS guidelines to meet the instructional goals of the course, with considerations given for individual needs. Modifications will be made for students with IEP and 504 plans as needed. As per NYSED guidance, students in grades 9 - 12 shall receive approximately 180 minutes per week of instructional experiences for each course in which they are enrolled.

Social-Emotional Support:

When school starts on September 8th, teachers and staff will be focused on building community and relationships in our all of our classes. Additional information about all social-emotional support is available on our district website at Student Support Services.
