



The indoor track team is breaking records again! On Sunday at a meet in Springfield, MA, Aidan Ifkovits and Mariah Odari both broke their own records in the weight throw and 55 dash respectively. Aidan's new record (58 feet) also qualifies him for the NY state meet using the NY superstandard. Aidan also set a new school record in the shot put-throwing it 43 feet 6 inches.
