HORTICULTURE

Spring is not yet here, but there are plenty of flowers in the Horticulture classes! In the first weeks of the class, students have been learning about the different characteristics to look for when identifying flowering plants through a variety of examples that thrive in different environmental conditions. Some interesting tricks that can be done inside during the winter months have also been demonstrated such as forcing a forsythia to bloom and modifying the color of a white rose using the plant's vascular tissue.
